July "ugust and September there will be nothing but the getting ready for fall gardens.

I certainly hope that by staying on this extra time there you are not losing more than you are gaining. Or maybe with the girls teaching, as they could not do here, ou would be losing to come. I would not venture to say. Anyway, altho we did go ahead and rent the trailer units here when they were vacant, Ragin is still holding the large house for you and I trust everything finally works out. Ragin was so badly in need of help ever since the vegetables harvest started because everybody goes in for that and it is impossible to get anyone but that is about over

now and help will be available.

Glad you saw Clyde and Jennie. Remeber us to Fred when you see him and ask him if it is not about time for another visit, to us.

Have several other letters to get done this P.M. before. evening church service, and lots to do tomorrow about getting off to Orlando and leaving things cooked up and fixed to help Ragin out while I am gone.
