Just a hasty note to tell you that I have so many things to talk over with you that I can only tell you now that I am planning on driving to the reunion, and hope you can arrange to ride mostly with me so we can have as much time together as possible. I have heard nothing further from any of the others as to dates, so am in the dark as to that factor.

In outline, my hope and plan is to make a car trip, at least as far south as Fannie's, and be down there somewhere when you come along and pick you up. Now Jesse, I want to tell you just a little word (for you only at present) that I am working hard on some matters concerning Jews, and the rapidly growing idea among foremost Jews and Christians everywhere that they will have to combine more and more closely in order to offset the frowning menace of the Godless.

I well remember a letter you wrote me a few years ago (while I was still in Zion City) that you wanted so much to come there and help "feed the sheep" there. But it could not be done then or there, as I think I can show you quite plainly when I have a chance. (And now, the Jews are taking everything over there, and have just about ousted Voliva completely.) But now the time has come, I am sure, when something very real, and powerful, and effective, can be done, and I am wishing - almost demanding - that you come and help me, for there is something very urgent that I am sure that you can take hold of effectively. I am therefore hoping that you will taper off your affairs there and be ready to look well into this - not so much as a matter of making money, but rather as a missionary service for God and His people. Have just a minute left to ~~it~~ catch the last mail. Pray much about this matter as to each of our parts in it.
