Dear Jesse :-

Just received a letter from Louina saying you were sick in bed with fever, and that Frank's wife had been injured by a fall, and had been in bed some time and would have to remain there for another month.

Am very sorry to hear about this, and wish you had written me direct about it so we could pray here.

Think you should about have the family letter in hand by now.

Was out to Waukegan to see Alton and Pauline and have supper with them last night. They are getting along very nicely. Have a cosy little apartment in North Chicago - do you remember the first town this side of Waukegan? He works for Armour Branch plant in Waukegan as salesman and sometimes delivery driver, and Pauline is sten. in a lawyer's office there.

They drove me down to Highland Park to see Joe, but he was out. Joe is driving a bakery truck for a large Milwaukee firm with several branches down this way.

We have not had a great deal of cold weather yet - just two short slides down to almost zero, and then back around freezing again, and after 10-15

degrees above. But we did have one awful snow storm, and there are some cars still almost buried right along our street - there being no room to throw the snow when they dig them out. But it has been warm and thawing for several days and snow fading away. However there is promised another severe freeze for the next several days.

My health still continues wonderfully good. Had a severe head cold about 10 days ago, but it soon passed away after prayer, and last Sunday A.M. at 6:30 I awakened with a splitting headache, followed by vomiting. Had every appearance of intestinal flu. But it ~~too~~ passed away in a few hours, and tho a little weak on Monday, I was all right again.

Did you receive my letter with snow pictures a few days ago?

We are praying for you here, and request a letter as to how you are. The cousins letter went to Stephen recently - two or three weeks ago I think.
