To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Stephen A. Crosby, a citizen of the United States, residing in Manhattan, in the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Stapling Machines, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof in which:—

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a stapling machine showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a plan view of Fig. 1 and

Fig. 3 is a front view of Fig. 1.

The essential feature of my invention resides in the split arm comprising a magazine and a swingable superimposed cover having a downwardly and rearwardly curved top face.

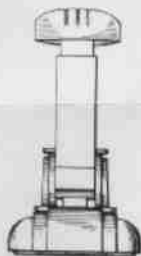
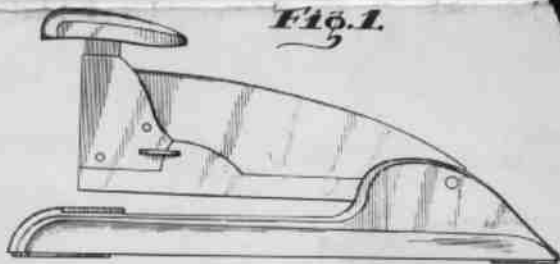
I claim:—
